

The Department of Mathematical Sciences at the University of Cincinnati is seeking applicants for three (3) full time, renewable contract positions of Educator Instructor/Assistant Professor (non tenure-track). Primary responsibilities are teaching and service and we anticipate a starting date that may be as early as September 1, 2011.

The successful candidate will be expected to have either experience in, or strategic plans for, teaching large enrollment mathematics courses and online courses. The department is particularly interested in candidates who can assist in curriculum development and teach courses in the newly developed program in actuarial science.

Minimally, the positions require a master's degree in Mathematics or Statistics, documented evidence of college-level mathematics teaching, experience in curriculum development, and collegiate service experience.

Preferred qualifications include a PhD in Mathematics, Statistics, or Mathematics Education (with evidence of graduate work in mathematics), experience teaching online courses, and experience teaching large enrollment (60+) mathematics classes.
